The RTC will participate in this national moment of remembrance, unity and pause for a one-minute bell ringing at its **Bonneville Transit Center, 101 E. Bonneville Ave, at 2:30 p.m.** Staff, contractors, customers, and media partners are invited to join in the event. Masks and social distancing will be required.
