

RTC's transit service includes the Deuce on the Strip, which runs every 15-20 minutes, 24 hours a day, offering convenience and flexibility for employees and visitors to the Las Vegas Resort Corridor. Thirtyeight other transit routes connect riders to destinations throughout the community, and customers can plan trips and purchase passes through the RTC's free rideRTC app.

For those flying this holiday weekend, the RTC offers free parking at the Centennial Hills Transit Center or the South Strip Transit Terminal with direct transit service to Harry Reid International Airport. Terminal 1 via the Centennial Express (CX) or Route 109 Maryland Parkway and to Terminal 3 via the CX.
