RTC urges Stanley Cup Parade attendees to plan ahead for traffic delays, use Game Day Express

Parade attendees can hop on the RTC Game Day Express from six convenient locations



LAS VEGAS – The Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) urges those planning to drive to the Las Vegas Strip or to attend the 2023 Stanley Cup Parade for the Vegas Golden Knights on Saturday, June 16 at 7 p.m., to plan ahead for traffic delays and transit detours.

Motorists should prepare for heavy traffic, as Las Vegas Blvd. between Tropicana Ave. and Flamingo Road will be closed. Expect subsequent delays in and around the area.

Attendees can easily get to the parade via Game Day Express buses from six convenient locations throughout the valley. Game Day Express transit passes can be purchased in cash for \$4 roundtrip at the pick-up locations. Attendees can also purchase 24-hour passes for \$5 on rideRTC, Transit, Lyft and Uber apps.

Due to the anticipated high demand, service will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Departure times are 4, 4:30 and 5 p.m. Following the parade, buses will depart approximately every 30 minutes from 8:30 to 10:30 p.m. on Excalibur Way.

Transit riders should be aware that the Deuce on the Strip will be detoured from approximately 3 to 10 p.m. until Las Vegas Blvd. reopens to the public. Route 201 (Tropicana) and Route 202 (Flamingo) may also experience delays because of the special event. Riders should plan ahead and, if necessary, consider boarding an earlier bus to ensure they get to their destination on time. Paratransit customers will not be able to book rides to locations inside of the parade area and should expect delays.
